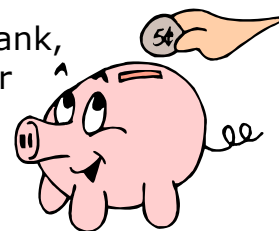

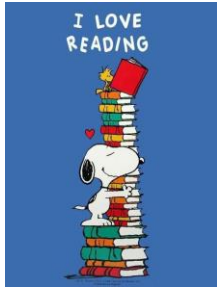
CHESS CLUB BEGINS FOR TERM 3 TOMORROW

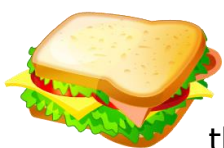
