Dear Parents,

Once again, we are at the end of another term. The staff have been working hard on preparing your child's report. There are some changes to this Semester's report, so I hope that you take a few minutes to sit back and look at our website, which has a small video explaining the changes.

School Production

This week saw the very first school rehearsal for our production. The children were extremely excited, but somewhat nervous at the same time, performing before a large crowd. *Please note the following:*

All students must stay for both performances (5.30pm and 7.30pm). You will not see your child after you drop them off (before the first performance) until after the end of the second performance. More details will follow early next term.

Tickets for the concert will be available only through Trybooking. This booking website will **go live** to purchase tickets on Wednesday 17th July at 5.00pm (first week of T3).

The Planetshakers Theatre is a large venue, with plenty of seating available. There is NO limit to the amount of tickets you are able to purchase for either/both performances.

Tickets will be \$25 per adult & \$10 per child/secondary school student. (Your 'production child' does NOT need a ticket).

NB prams/pushers are NOT allowed into the theatre.

We have enlisted the services of a new video company this year, and we have been assured that the quality will be excellent. An order form will go home via your child on the first Thursday of term 3.

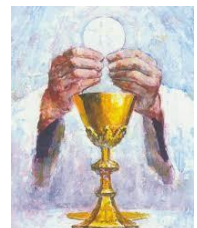
This is the last newsletter for this term, so I wish all families a wonderful school holiday break.

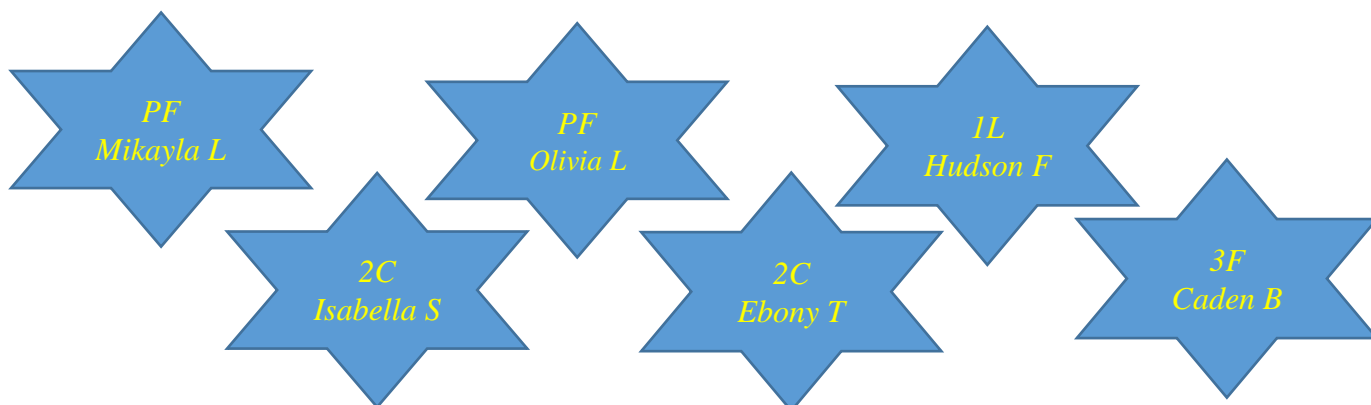
