### **PALINDROMES**

On Sunday, the date was 02/02/2020, this date is a palindrome, because it reads the same way forward as it does backwards, so this date written forwards 02022020 looks the same written backwards 02022020.

The last time this occurred was over 900 years ago when the date was 11/11/1111. Can you work out the date of the next Palindrome, without using the Internet? (Hint: It is not in this century)

If the date is written as d/m/yy, eg: 2/2/20, then Sunday was not a Palindrome, however the 9th of January 2019 was, eg: 9/1/19, 9119. Written in this format, when will the next Palindrome date be?

\*\*There are lots of discussions you can have around palindromes, including thinking of a list of words and numbers that are palindromes. For example: mum, dad, madam, or numbers 22, 313, 8228. If your children are in the junior school, the dates might be a bit difficult for them to understand; you can write a list of numbers or words that are palindromes that they know.
